

BARBADOS TURF CLUB
CONDUCT AND DRESS CODE REGULATIONS - RACEDAY GUIDE
INCITATUS MEMBERS LOUNGE

1. Membership is individual and an important part of the Club. Every member binds him/herself to abide by the rules under the control of the Barbados Turf Club and the social conduct of the members lounge and other venues upon acceptance as a member of the Barbados Turf Club.
2. Membership identification badge and valid yearly card, should be carried by members at all times. The use of a membership badge or card used by anyone other than the member will result in the badge/card being confiscated and disciplinary and other possible action taken against that member, including termination of the right of membership.
3. Members may bring one (1) guest into the lounge upon each visit, but may at times have to pay for their guest on a specified race day. The guest name should be given to the Secretary at least 24 hours in advance. If there is more than one (1) guest the member will have to pay for them 24 hours in advance; the names must be given to the Secretary. Members wishing to bring three (3) or more guests into the lounge must request permission and pay for them 24 hours in advance.
4. A limited number of tables in the lounge are available at an annual rental fee; depending however on availability at the time of request. A member can rent a table sitting (5) five people. All arrangements must be made in advance with the Secretary.
5. All guests must wear their identity cards at all times.
6. No person under the age of 12 years will be permitted into the lounge without supervision.
7. Members are not to permit or invite non member persons to access the lounge.
8. Members are responsible for the behavior of their guest at all times and will be financially liable for their charges.
9. **DRESS CODE:** Members and guests should be appropriately dressed; smart and comfortable and in a manner that reflects an elegant demeanor, and or a business casual dress with a pleasing degree of discretion.

LADIES

Ladies are encouraged to dress smartly for a formal occasion:

- Dresses and skirts should be of modest length, that is, they **MUST fall just above the knee or longer.**
- Dresses and tops should have straps of one inch (2.5 cm) or greater.
- Strapless, off the shoulder, halter neck, spaghetti strapped dresses and tops are **NOT** permitted. Midriffs must be covered.
- Trousers or Pants suits are welcome but they **MUST** be of full length (ankle)
- Slippers, sandals, flip flops, sneakers and beach wear are **NOT** permitted.

GENTLEMEN

- Gentlemen **MUST** wear formal collared shirts and full-length trousers. **Jeans are NOT permitted.**
- **T-shirts and Polo-shirts are NOT permitted.**
- Formal enclosed shoes are accepted, but Trainers are not allowed.
- Slippers, sandals, flip flops, sneakers and beach wear are **NOT** permitted.

CHILDREN

- **GIRLS** (aged 10-17) must be dressed for a formal occasion, in accordance with the ladies' dress code. Smart summer dresses are accepted.
- Slippers, sandals, flip flops, sneakers and beach wear are **NOT** permitted.
- **BOYS** (aged 10-17) must be dressed in accordance with the gentlemen's dress code i.e. includes full-length trousers and formal enclosed shoes. However Jacket not compulsory.
- T-shirts and Polo-shirts are **NOT** permitted.

The Barbados Turf Club reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone who is deemed inappropriately dressed.

10. **DRESS CODE FOR BARBADOS GOLD CUP**

MEN:- Elegantly attired: tailored trousers, shirts with collars and sleeves, ties and shoes, and preferably jackets.

WOMEN:- Dresses, skirts, tailored pants and blouses; elegant in dress style and design and appropriate foot wear.

11. **NOT PERMITTED:** Faded or torn clothing, jeans, sweat shirts, athletic shoes, casual sandals or apparel with slogans, slander or commercial messages. No beach wear of any style or kind.

12. Members and their guests should act in a manner that is respectful and courteous to other members and guests, members of staff and third parties, regardless, to their race, creed, colour, religion, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, disability or marital status; should not be harmful and abusive or offensive. Failure to act respectfully will result in eviction and exclusion from the property.

13. Misconduct includes the breach of the drug rules, policy and laws of the Government of Barbados. Any infringement will be dealt with immediately according to the laws of the country and the rules of the Barbados Turf Club.

14. We asked that you respect others around and refrain from prolonged cellular telephone calls. Should you be required to have an extended call, kindly leave the lounge to another area of the premises.

15. Absolutely No Smoking in the Lounge or on the premises.

16. Destruction, damaging, defraying any of the property or removing property, or any article belonging to the Club; by any member or any member's guest will make that member financially liable for all charges..

17. We appreciate any idea, suggestion or feed back which will improve any aspect of the Club, they will be considered by the management. You may submit same in writing.

18. **DISCLAIMER** : Loss or injury to any member or guest or to any goods or property of theirs on the premises of the Barbados Turf Club should not give rise to any claim against the Club, its Officials or any employee.

19. You should immediately report to the Club's office if your badge or card is lost or stolen. There will be a replacement charge for the badge.
